



S2 GERMAN WRITING ASSESSMENT

For your forthcoming German writing assessment, you will produce a letter introducing yourself to an imaginary pen friend.

You will write the letter as homework. Your writing should be as accurate as possible since you will be doing **only one draft**. You should use your vocabulary guides. These will give you ideas, as well as help you check spelling, gender, etc.

You will be awarded a grade at Level C, Level D, Level E or Level F. The level you gain will depend on:-

- a) how accurate your writing is
- b) how much information you give
- c) how varied the language is

All levels should give information from the following bullet points.

- ◆ Introduce yourself by giving your name, age and birthday.
- ◆ Give information about where you live.
- ◆ Describe yourself (hair, eyes, build and character)
- ◆ Give information on your family and any pets
- ◆ Give information about your school
- ◆ Give your opinion of some school subjects
- ◆ Give information about your hobbies and what you do in your spare time.
- ◆ Say what you did, e.g. last weekend (letztes Wochenende) - **Level E/F only**
- ◆ Ask questions

NOTE

Begin your letter with Lieber + boy's name (dear) or
Liebe + girl's name (dear)

End the letter with the words "Viele Grüße," (Kind regards) and
dein + your name (if you are a boy)
deine + your name (if you are a girl)
